Teams may consist of four members, with the three highest scores being used. There will be a junior division (8th grade and below), and a senior division (9th-12th grade). Individuals who wish to compete without a team are welcome. In order for junior members to qualify for High Point Awards, they should not be placed on a Senior Team. The number of teams entered per chapter/club is unlimited.

The Livestock Judging Contest will consist of the following:

- 8 Classes and 2 Questions Class
