



County Roundup Contest Opportunities

Roundup contests are a great way to meet other youth in the county. Roundup consists of several contests for youth to participate. Youth may choose to demonstrate or illustrate something, write a speech, gain knowledge in a specific topic, but, most importantly, youth will be able to share their knowledge and/or talent.

County Contests – Thursday, April 7, 2016 at the Extension Office, start time is at 4:00 p.m. If you need an earlier or later time or date, please indicate that on the registration form to request a different time. – To enter the county contests, please complete the "Roundup Registration Form" at the following link by March 31st:

District Contest – Saturday, April 30, 2016 at Lockhart Junior High in Lockhart, TX. Youth must compete (speak or perform before a Travis County Extension agent) at the county level to advance to the district level.

*** On the next page, there is a chart indicating the different contests in which youth may participate. *Note that various events are on different days at State 4-H Roundup.*

Educational Presentations: Youth may enter this event as either an individual or a team (up to 5 members). Contest categories include: Beef, Clothing and Textiles, Companion Animals, Health, Horse, Open ANR, Open-FCS, Open-General, Promote 4-H, Safety and Injury Prevention, and Sheep and/or Goats.

- May use PowerPoint or other visual aides for assistance
- Must not be longer than 12 minutes in length (9 minutes to set up and break down)
- Can have 1 to 5 team members
- Prepare a demonstration or illustrated talk on a specific subject.

Contest Overview:

The Discover Scientific Method Research Poster Contest is designed to help youth identify a question or problem and then focus on learning and solving the problem using the scientific method in the following project areas:

- Biochemistry/Microbiology/Food Science
- Environmental Science/Chemistry/Earth Sciences
- Animal Science
- Plant and Soil Science
- Engineering/Physics
- Consumer Product Testing

Topics can cover any field as long as it is research oriented and may include humanities or social sciences that meet the research criteria. The County Extension Agent, or their designee, will document and certify all projects.
