SUBJECT: 4-H SHOOTING SPORTS COACH CERTIFICATION TRAINING

Thank you for interest in the Rolling Plains – **District 3 Texas 4-H Shooting Sports Coach Training to be held October 21-22, 2017 in Wichita County. Archery, Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun disciplines will be offered at this event.**

Registration will be open on Texas 4-H Connect starting September 11 – October 9, 2017. Registration is \$125 per person. Registration types are as follows: Coach, Assistant Coach – Adult, Assistant Coach – Youth, and Extension Employee. Participant may only be trained in one discipline at this training and will select at registration.

Note* - Participants MUST have a current and complete 4-H Connect volunteer/member profile to register for the event. This includes an up-to-date background check for adults. **No exceptions will be allowed for the registration deadline!**

In addition, the Waiver, Indemnification, and Medical Treatment Authorization Form are attached that is required to participate. Those in Shotgun will be asked to complete the range form. Please print the forms, complete and sign, and bring the originally signed forms with you to turn in at check-in on Saturday morning. These forms will also be available to you when you register on 4-H Connect.

If you are a Youth Assistant Coach Candidate, you will need to also bring the originally signed copy of the Assistant Coach Acknowledgement Youth Form with you. It is attached. You will also turn this form in at check-in on Saturday morning.

Attached are the details regarding the training including the items you will need to bring with you to the training. Please let my office know if you require additional information.

SHOOTING SPORTS COACHES TRAINING

What To Bring As A Training Participant

Everyone attending should bring the following:

- Signed Waiver, Indemnification, and Medical Treatment Authorization Form (attached)
- Assistant Coach Acknowledgement Youth Form (if youth candidate; attached)
- 3-ring binder (2" or larger recommended)
- writing materials and extra paper for notes
- highlighters if you use them for stressed points
- eye protection (shooting glasses or goggles) – recommended for archery, mandatory for all other disciplines
- ear protection (plugs or muffs) – mandatory for shotgun, rifle, and pistol disciplines
- comfortable outdoor clothing, including a cap or hat suitable for the prevailing weather and be prepared for inclement weather
- sunscreen
- range chairs if desired
- open mind ready to learn and share

Shotgun discipline participants:

- 20 or 12 gauge shotgun, any action type
- Ammunition pouch or vest
- 2 boxes of shells

Archery discipline participants:

- Bow, of any style. Note: hunting bows > 40 lbs - please be left at home.
- Appropriate arrows, practice points only, no broad head hunting points

Rifle discipline participants:

- .22 caliber small bore rifle, of any style, preferably bolt action
- 1 box of .22 ammunition

Pistol discipline participants:

- .22 caliber small bore pistol, of any style
- 1 box of .22 ammunition
