POT ENTRY RULES (CASH ONLY)

- Fishing pots per team. You will only be eligible to win in the pots you enter.
- Any fish may be entered in only one category.
- All Fish Pots \$50.00—Pays 50%, 30%, 20%
- One Fish Per Team
 - Heaviest Trout
 - Heaviest Redfish
- Texas Slam—(1) Trout; (1) Redfish; (1) Flounder

(If no winner in the Texas Slam we will draw winners from the entries)

- All persons in boat must be entered in tournament. Limit 6 persons per boat.
- All Federal, State, and tournament rules will be abided by, including a valid fishing license. NO OVERSIZED TAGGED REDFISH ALLOWED.
- In keeping with the philosophy of the conservation of the fishery, only one trout 25 inches or more will be allowed at weigh-in, per team.
- No one with a U.S. Coast Guard Captain's License that has professionally guided in the last 5 years may fish in this tournament.
- The fishing area will be restricted to the following areas: Matagorda Bay and to east Cotton's Bayou, Tres Palacios Bay, Espiritu Santos Bay, San Antonio Bay, Mission Bay, Hines Bay, Lavaca Bay, Keller Bay, Carancahua Bay and the Intercoastal waterway to the south side of San Antonio Bay.
- All fish must be caught by pole or rod & reel in adherence to the State Law.
- All fish submitted for weigh-in must be in fresh edible condition. Frozen, thawed, spoiled, pale, gilled or altered (tall shaving) fish not in its natural state will be disqualified.
- In the event of a tie for weight, length will determine the winner.
- No swapping of fish after team member is in line for weigh-in. Teams not in line by 5:00 pm will not be eligible.
- Any team violating State or Federal law will be disqualified.

FINAL. NO APPEALS.**
