10 am: Lamb Showmanship
Followed by Lamb Show
Followed by Goat Showmanship
Followed by Goat Show
Judge: Vance Christi, Brady, TX

Sunday, October 6, 2013
8 am-9 am: Heifer Check-In
9am - 10am: Steer Check-In
10 am - Beef Showmanship
Followed by Heifer Show
Followed by Steer Show
Judge: Micah Walker, Fredricksburg, TX

The prospect show will be open to all junior livestock exhibitors. Must be a 4-H or FFA member.

STEERS

1. Dressing is not allowed. Steers will be shown with no artificial hair, no adhesives: **Blow and Show!!!**
2. Classes will be split in the three breed divisions. Weight classes will be determined by number of entries.
3. Show order: (a) American, (b) British, and (c) European.
4. Final classification will be at the discretion of the Judge.

HEIFERS

1. Heifers shall be registered in their respective associations in the name of the exhibitor.
2. Dressing is not allowed. (Same rules as steers).
3. Classes:
CLASS 1: Born January 1, 2013 or after
CLASS 2: Born September 1 - December 31, 2012
CLASS 3: Born May 1 - August 31, 2012
CLASS 4: Born January 1 - April 30, 2012
CLASS 5: Born September 1 - December 31, 2011
4. Adjustments in the above classes may be made at the discretion of the show officials.
5. Show order: (a) American, (b) British, and (c) European

GOATS

1. Turn in your own weight cards. A 4-pound tolerance will be allowed on weigh back. Goats that weigh out will be disqualified. Weigh backs will be at the discretion of the judge and/or show officials.
2. Wethers and Nannies are eligible to show.
3. Exhibitors will be required to have horns tipped blunt on all goats.
4. Classes will be split based on the number of entries.
5. Goats may be shown with halters or collars.

LAMBS

1. Turn in your own weight cards. A 4-pound tolerance will be allowed on weigh back. Lambs that weigh out will be disqualified. Weigh back will be at the discretion of the judge and/or show officials.
2. Wether and Ewe lambs are eligible.
3. Lambs that classify out will be moved to another class.
4. Classes will be split in the four breed divisions based on the number of entries.

LAMBS (Cont.)

- 5. Show order: (a) Fine Wool, (b) Fine Wool-Cross, (c) Southdown, and (d) Medium Wool
- 6. All lambs must be shorn slick.

SHOWMANSHIP

- 1. There will be a Pee-Wee, Sub-Junior, Junior and Senior Showmanship Division in beef, lamb & goat.
 - A. Sub-Junior: 8 to 11 years old as of show date
 - B. Junior: 12 to 14 years old as of show date
 - C. Senior: 15 years old and over as of show date
- 2. Entry fee is \$5.00 for showmanship, PeeWees are free

AWARDS

- 1. Belt buckles will go to Grand Champion.
- 2. There will be an award for Reserve Champion.
- 3. Awards will be presented to Champion and Reserve Champion winners in each of the following breed categories: Southdown Lamb, Fine Wool Lamb, Fine Wool Cross Lamb, Medium Wool Lamb, American Breed Steer, British Breed Steer, European Breed Steer, American Breed Heifer, British Breed Heifer, European Breed Heifer, Heavy Weight Goat, Medium Weight Goat, Light Weight Goat.
- 4. Plaques for Showmanship.

ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES

- 1. Steers and Heifers - \$20.00 per head
- 2. Lambs and Goats - \$15.00 per head
- 3. Showmanship - \$ 5.00 - pay at check-in
- 4. Early entry deadline is September 20, 2013.
- 5. Entry fees **MUST** be paid with early entries.
- 6. No refunds for entries.
- 7. No late fees.
