Eligibility: 4-H & FFA Youth, 13 years of age and older (in the Lamb and Goat Projects)

Monday, November 25, 2013.

Open to first 15 registrants

Contest will consist of two (2) components

Showmanship Challenge – youth will demonstrate showmen skills while speaker gives presentation and will be required to work with the 4-H CAPITAL goats. Participants will switch goats to have equal opportunity and will be judged on patience and ability to follow instructions of speaker.

Leadership Challenge – participants will be assigned to CAPITAL youth participants to assist, but not get in the way. Random number selection will be drawn to ensure fairness

Rules

- Not allowed to move or position animals– unless told to assist with walking in circle
- Not allowed to move or position youth
- Not allowed to get in the way between judge and animals
- Not allowed to be a quarterback dad
- Must stay behind/ to the side of CAPITAL youth participant
- Must exercise the 6 pillars of character
