





Train Like a Champion Information & Guidelines

General Show Information

- Entry fees are \$20/head until Monday, July 24, 2017
- Late entries will be accepted at \$25/head before 9:00am on show day
- Exhibitors & parents are expected to attend the clinics in order for exhibitors to be eligible to show.
- There will be a \$5/exhibitor Showmanship Contest for Steers, Heifers, Lambs, and Goats. Classes will be evaluated based on entry numbers and are subject to change by Show Officials. Showmanship Classes will be:
 - Senior (9th Grade 12th Grade)
 - Intermediate $(6^{th} 8^{th} Grade)$
 - Junior (5th Grade and Under)
- Unruly livestock will be dismissed at the discretion of Show Officials.
- Shavings will NOT be allowed in the barn.
- Stock Show Pro Livestock Supply Trailer will be onsite.

Steer Show

- A scale will be provided for exhibitors to weigh their animals. There will be a 5% weigh back at the discretion of Show Officials.
- Exhibitors will self-classify steer entries into one of three divisions: American, British, or Exotic.
 Classifications will be reviewed by Show Officials at the time of the show and can be sifted if
 deemed necessary.
- Exhibitors who would like help classifying steers may come to the check-in office and Show Officials will assist.

Heifer Show

- Exhibitors will enter heifer into one of the four divisions: American, British, Exotic, or Commercial.
- The Commercial division is for non-registered heifers only. Entries in this division are expected to have a County Fair Commercial Heifer Ear Tag.
- The American, British, and Exotic divisions will have classes based on age.
- The Commercial division will have classes based on weight.
- A scale will be provided for exhibitors to weigh their animals. There will be a 5% weigh back at the discretion of Show Officials.
- Registered heifer exhibitors are asked to bring registration papers for review by Show Official should an inquiry be made.
- The number of classes will be determined by Show Officials based on the number of entries.

Sheep and Goat Show

- A scale will be provided for exhibitors to weigh their animals. There will be a 5lb weigh back at the discretion of Show Officials.
- There will be no breed breakdown for sheep; classes will be determined by weight only.
