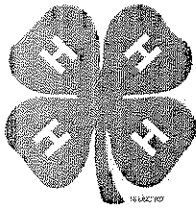


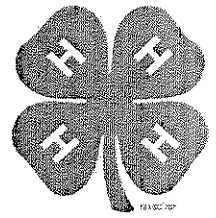

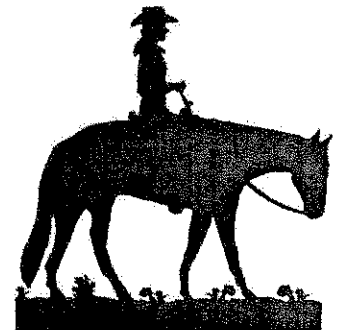

## SHOW RULES

### Clover Rules

1. Parents may help their child in the arena during the class.
2. Exhibitors will all receive an overall prize.
3. Exhibitors will not be placed but will all receive a ribbon for each class in which the child shows.
4. This division is a **walk/trot only for beginner riders!**

### Youth Rules

1. Exhibitors will show in two divisions. (Open Youth & County 4-Hers)  
(Classes maybe run together but will be judged separately depending on entries)
2. Youth exhibitors may only enter **one** horse per class but multiple horses can be shown. (Example: An exhibitor can show one horse in barrels and a different one for poles.)
3. Exhibitors can show one mare and one gelding at halter.
4. Points are given by exhibitor not by horse. (Exhibitor doesn't have to pick a point horse.)
5. Futurity horses do not count for points. (Yearling Classes)
6. High point awards will be given in Western, English, and Timed Divisions.
7. Points will be determined by the number of exhibitors in each class.  
(Example-8 entries in the class: 1<sup>st</sup>-8, 2<sup>nd</sup>-7, 3<sup>rd</sup>-6, 4<sup>th</sup>-5, etc.)
8. A buckle will be awarded to the high point rider over-all in each division. Points from **ALL CLASSES** and **ALL HORSES** entered by the child will be used to determine the winner.
9. A youth exhibitor and an adult exhibitor cannot show the same horse in the same class. (Example: Child shows horse in halter then adult **can** show same horse in pleasure but **not halter**.)
10. A parent or trainer cannot give instruction during a class.

### Adult Rules

1. Exhibitors can enter **multiple** horses in **each class** where possible.
2. There will not be a high point award for adults.
3. Ribbons will be awarded in each class.
