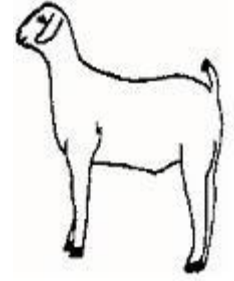

Facts concerning the Goat Camp:

1. There will be a charge of \$85.00 per person (every person). This includes three meals and a camp tee shirt or cap. **Add \$50 per goat provided by Howard College.
2. **Participants need to make their own hotel reservations.** The Holiday Inn Express will serve as the host hotel. Mention the camp for the special rate of \$119/night. Contact Holiday Inn Express at 432-263-5400 for reservations.
3. Bring all necessary show equipment. (Bring chains if borrowing a goat)
4. **If possible, bring your own goat for demonstration purposes.**
5. **Registration** is Sunday, June 14th, 9:00 A.M. -- 11:30 Noon at the **G.C. Broughton, Jr. Ag Complex.**
6. Participants must be 9 years old or entering the 3rd Grade
