

Travis County 4-H 2017-2018 Major Show Broiler Order Form

(One Form/Order per family unit)

Order Deadline: September 25, 2017 to Travis County Extension Office

Please note: Birds must be ordered in multiples of 25, with a minimum order of 25, and a maximum of 75 per exhibitor (or a maximum of 75 per family if sharing the birds with siblings in the same household). Individuals/Families may submit one order for the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo (HSLR)/Rodeo Austin (RA) hatch date and one order for the San Antonio Stock Show and Rodeo (SASSR) Hatch Date. We recommend ordering more than the minimum and culling at regular intervals during the growing process.

This order is due in the Extension office by Monday, September 25, 2017. Orders submitted after September 25th **must** include a \$25.00 late fee in addition to the fee for the ordered chicks. Late orders will be accepted until Friday, September 29, 2017. Payment is due at the time of submission.

Birds should arrive around the first week of January 2017 for all SASSR

Birds should arrive around the fourth week of January 2017 for HLSR/RA
