

2014 Travis County and District 10 4-H Textile Contest

***** Youth may enter the county contest only or the county and the District 10 Contest *****

- There is no fee to enter the county contest if you're a registered 4-H member. If youth is not a registered 4-H member, there is a \$10.00 entry fee.
- Participants must follow District 10 guidelines (**below**) for county contest entries.
- If entering the county only contest, submit your items to the extension office by May 1st.
- If entering the District Contest, youth must register on 4-H Connect by April 17th and deliver items to the extension office by May 1st.
- Cory will take all district entered items on May 3rd or families may take the items themselves.

GUIDELINES

- May enter any item constructed from fabric or textile material (ex: crochet, needlework). Entries may be garments that are not entered in the Fashion Show.
- May enter any item constructed as an accessory to a garment.
- May be constructed from a pattern, a kit, or be an original design.
- Each participant is limited to one single item per entry division.
- Item must have been made within the current year: May 1, 2013 to District Contest (May 3, 2014).
- Any 4-H member that participated in their county 4-H Clothing & Textile project is eligible to participate.
- 4-H member must attach one (1) entry card per item.

ENTRY DIVISIONS

- Jewelry - examples: earrings, necklace
- Household Item - examples: blanket, pillowcase, rug
- Kitchen Item - examples: pot holder, place-mat, apron
- Accessory Item - examples: hair bow, purse, flip-flops with ribbons tied on (meant to be worn with a garment)
- Embellished Item - purchased item that has appearance altered by use of embellishments. Examples: tote with iron-on transfer applied, pillow with lace border sewn on, etc.
- Holiday Textile Item - holiday decorations. Any holiday item using fabric and/or other sewing notions. Examples: ornaments, tree skirts, pumpkins, Easter rabbits, etc.

AGE CATEGORIES

- Junior - 8, 9 or 10 years old as of August 31, 2013
- Intermediate - 11, 12 or 13 years old as of August 31, 2013
- Senior - 14 to 18 years old as of August 31, 2013

AWARDS

- Blue, Red, White Quality ribbons will be given in each entry division of each age category.
- A Best of Show winner will be picked from Blue Quality division winners in each division and an overall Best of Show Quality ribbon will be awarded in each age division.

ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

- Registration is due on 4-H Connect by April 17, 2014.
- Enter your item(s) at the designated area on the same day as the District 10 Fashion Show on (April 27, 2014. Need not be present to enter.
- Public viewing will be open after judging.
- Pick up entries and awards before the awards program begins.

JUDGING EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. ***Originality*** - 20 points
Item displays creativity and originality and/or uniqueness.
2. ***Presentation/General Appearance*** - 20 points
Item is neat and clean; nicely pressed
3. ***Workmanship*** - 20 points
Item is well constructed and stitching (if applicable) is uniform and neat. Techniques used were appropriate for the item.
4. ***Use of Design Elements*** - 20 points
Line, form/shape, color/value and texture are appropriate for the item.
5. ***Use of Design Principles*** - 20 points
Proportion and scale, balance, rhythm, emphasis and unity, or harmony, are appropriate for the item.
 - Proportion is the relation of various parts in the whole design
 - Scale refers to the overall size of an item compared with other objects, shapes or space.
 - Balance is the sense of equilibrium and repose (symmetrical and asymmetrical)
 - Rhythm is the repeated use of lines, shapes, colors, trims, or detail that create a pattern.
 - Emphasis is the focal point of interest.
 - Harmony presents a pleasing visual effect.
